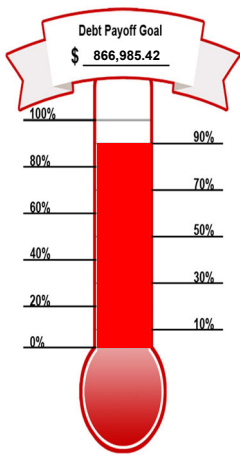

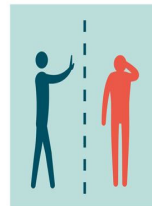

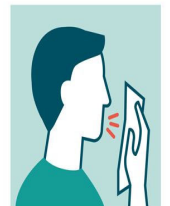

FEMA FUNERAL EXPENSE REINBURSEMENT FOR COVID FATALITIES

The assistance will include reimbursement for funeral expense to families who have experienced the death of loved one due to the COVID 19 virus, since January 2020.

Required documentation:

- Application process will open in April 2021, which will require some documentation and have eligibility requirements.
 - Death must have occurred in the United States, including the U.S. territories and the District of Columbia.
 - Death certificate must indicate that the passing was attributed to COVID-19. This does NOT mean, as I understand it, that the death itself cannot be the result of other fatal health conditions, but that those conditions were aggravated by COVID -19 and thus COVID 19 expedited the passing of the individual and caused the death prematurely.
 - The **applicant** must be a U.S. citizen, non-citizen national or qualified alien, who incurred funeral expenses. **There is no requirement that the actual deceased person be a U.S. citizen, non-citizen national or qualified alien...just the applicant!** This is an important distinction.
 - Documentation of funeral expenses such as receipts from funeral home contracts, cemetery costs, burial expenses, cemetery plots/mausoleums etc. will be required.
 - Documentation, when submitted, should include the applicant's name, the deceased's name, the amount of funeral expenses, and the dates the funeral expenses were incurred.
- Funds will be transmitted via check by mail or direct deposit, once application is received and approved.

Further details will be available when the formal process begins; but, it is advisable to begin gathering this information and conducting this careful pastoral outreach to those you know who have been impacted now. Thus, it is wise for anyone eligible to begin gathering the necessary information, receipts, death certificates now so as to be prepared to file promptly when the program itself is actually launched.

REEMBOLSO DE GASTOS FUNERARIOS DE FEMA POR FATALIDADES COVID

La asistencia incluirá el reembolso de los gastos funerarios a las familias que han experimentado la muerte de un ser querido debido al virus COVID 19, desde enero de 2020.

Documentos requeridos:

- El proceso de solicitud se abrirá en abril de 2021, lo que requerirá cierta documentación y tendrá requisitos de elegibilidad.
- La muerte debe haber ocurrido en los Estados Unidos, incluidos los territorios de los EE. UU. Y el Distrito de Columbia.
- El certificado de defunción debe indicar que la muerte se atribuyó a COVID-19. Esto NO significa, según tengo entendido, que la muerte en sí misma no puede ser el resultado de otras condiciones de salud fatales, sino que esas condiciones fueron agravadas por COVID -19 y, por lo tanto, COVID 19 aceleró el fallecimiento del individuo y causó la muerte prematuramente.
- El solicitante debe ser ciudadano estadounidense, nacional no ciudadano o extranjero calificado, que incurrió en gastos funerarios. No existe ningún requisito de que la persona fallecida sea un ciudadano de los EE. UU., Un ciudadano no ciudadano o un extranjero calificado ... ¡solo el solicitante! Esta es una distinción importante.
- Se requerirá documentación de los gastos del funeral, como recibos de los contratos de la funeraria, costos del cementerio, gastos del entierro, parcelas del cementerio / mausoleos, etc.

La documentación, cuando se presente, debe incluir el nombre del solicitante, el nombre del difunto, el monto de los gastos del funeral y las fechas en que se incurrió en los gastos del funeral. Los fondos se transmitirán mediante cheque por correo o depósito directo, una vez que se reciba y apruebe la solicitud.

Más detalles estarán disponibles cuando comience el proceso formal; pero es aconsejable comenzar a recopilar esta información y llevar a cabo este cuidadoso acercamiento pastoral a aquellos que usted conoce que han sido impactados ahora, ya que es poco probable que estén al tanto de esto todavía. Por lo tanto, es aconsejable que cualquier persona que reúna los requisitos comience a recopilar la información necesaria, los recibos y los certificados de defunción ahora para estar preparados para presentarlos rápidamente cuando el programa en sí se inicie.
